

Terms and Conditions of the Newsletter of the Rescue the Wildness Foundation

I.

1. The administrator of the websites www.ocalmydzikosc.pl and www.rescuthewildness.com is Fundacja Ocalmy Dzikość (Rescue the Wildness Foundation) with official seat in Ryki at Warszawska 3b st., postal-code 08-500, Poland, NIP no. 5060115264, KRS no. 000069112, hereinafter referred to as the Foundation.
2. The websites can be accessed by any natural or legal persons, hereinafter referred to as the User.
3. One of the functionalities of the websites specified in point 1 of this section is a newsletter function, hereinafter referred to as the newsletter.
4. For the purpose of this Terms and Conditions the newsletter is such a system of exchange of information between the Foundation and the User, where the Foundation may provide the User with electronic messages to the e-mail address of the User, anytime and of any content.

II.

1. Any User specified in point 2 of section I may use the newsletter.
2. The User begins to use the newsletter when he provides the Foundation with his e-mail address with use of the websites specified in point 1 section I, in a certain place specifying that the User provides the address for the purpose of using the newsletter, by clicking the button labeled with "Subscribe" word.
3. Term of utilization of the newsletter by the User is indefinite.
4. The User may terminate utilization of the newsletter anytime, effective after seven days from the moment of successful delivery of such termination, in accordance with point 5 of this section.
5. Termination of the utilization of the newsletter must be delivered to the Foundation electronically to the e-mail address: office@rescuthewildness.com, by mail to the official seat of the Foundation or personally to the official seat of the Foundation.
6. The foundation reserves the right to terminate, extend, modify or reduce the functionality of the newsletter anytime.
7. The User may use the newsletter free of charge.
8. To use the newsletter an internet connection is necessary, as well as a device and software able to read electronic messages from the electronic mail (e-mail) of the User.

III.

1. If the User uses the newsletter, the Foundation may provide him with messages to his electronic mail (e-mail) anytime, of any content and in any number.

IV.

1. The Foundation will not bear responsibility for improper functioning of the newsletter due to reasons related to the provider of internet services, provider of electronic mail (e-mail) services, as well as to devices and software of the User.
2. The Foundation will not bear responsibility for any costs of telecommunication services, also including the costs resulting from downloading the content from the internet by the User's device in the background.
